Cargill Bids Farewell to Teaching Career

Medicine Lodge Junior/Senior High is saying goodbye to one of their own, Patricia Cargill. Cargill has decided to retire from her position as the foreign language teacher in order to focus on her health as she was recently diagnosed with ALS.

Cargill had been in the education field for 30 years, teaching at Medicine Lodge for 27 of those

years, with foreign language being her main focus for 12 of those 27 years. Cargill held a few different positions within the Medicine Lodge District over the years, a para, at risk para, ESL teacher, and then the Spanish teacher for the Medicine Lodge Junior/Senior High School.

Cargill moved to the United States from Mexico when she was 10 years old to be closer to her father who worked in the States. As she went through school, she

realized she wanted to teach and went on to get her degree.

Cargill had the opportunity to study abroad her junior year of college and she spent one semester at The University of Barcelona in Barcelona, Spain.

"I am from a Spanish speaking family, I am from Mexico and we moved here when I was 10. My family speaks Spanish at home so it was just natural for me to pursue that path. It's sharing my culture, my background and my language

through teaching," Cargill said about why she chose to teach Spanish.

Cargill looks back fondly at her time teaching at Medicine Lodge, especially getting the opportunity to share her culture with her students through their fiesta days and daily lessons and she will miss seeing her students and other staff members every day.

"Of course I will miss all the students. In my classes, I always had really good students who

really wanted to learn and be there so first the students and then of course being there at ML High School and being with my peers and having that routine that I followed each day," Cargill said.

One thing that Cargill loved the most about teaching Spanish was the fiesta days they held to celebrate various holidays within her culture and other cultures around the world. "(My favorite memory) would

Meta to Pay 47 States \$17.1B in Settlement

Meta, the owner of Facebook and Instagram, on Wednesday agreed to pay 47 states, the District of Columbia, and a handful of U.S. territories, up to \$17.1 billion in penalties over claims that its social media platforms are addictive and a danger to children.

As part of the settlement, Meta also pledged to make changes to Instagram and Facebook that are designed to reduce young people's use of the platforms.

"Meta intentionally exploited kids for profit and then lied about it, claiming its products were safe when its own internal research confirmed the platforms were addictive and harmful," said Washington, D.C. Attorney General Brian Schwab, a Democrat, in a statement announcing the settlement.

"The physical, mental and emotional harms that intentionally addictive social media inflict on youth – and particularly teenage girls – are widespread across the tech industry, and this successful, coordinated multistage litigation has resulted in Meta being the first platform to come to the table and agree to such comprehensive reforms," he

3D Printing Could Help Kansans Without Tornado Shelters

As real estate prices continue to rise in Kansas, many people are turning to manufactured housing because they are less expensive to build, averaging about \$123,000 per home. About 4 percent of Kansans live in these modular homes.

Some officials see them as one solution to building more affordable housing. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has recently proposed rule changes to expand the definition of a manufactured home

and encourage multi-story manufactured housing construction.

It's also housing that can be overlooked. For example, many of these manufactured housing communities lack access to storm shelters. In Kansas, requirements vary by city for storm shelters at these communities. This can leave residents with no place to go when a storm approaches.

Reese Greenlee is an assistant professor of architecture at Kansas State University. When he moved to Kansas, he said the lack of publicly available storm shelters in the state stuck out.

Greenlee said while more than 20 million people live in manufactured homes across the country, architects have sometimes ignored them. They might not devote time to building important resources, like storm shelters, in these communities because they're often in out-of-the-way locations or are perceived as "cheap" housing.

"Unfortunately, manufactured housing has really been stigmatized culturally, and so architecture has kind of overlooked it," he said. "That's where my research starts, looking at them as a significant American housing landscape."

Greenlee started working with Shelby Doyle, associate professor of architecture at Iowa State University, and researchers at Iowa State's Computation and Construction Lab on a solution.

They are currently exploring whether shelters made from 3D-printed concrete bricks can be effective for these communities.

Traditionally, storm shelters have a concrete shell surrounding a steel or a reinforced concrete structure. They can be expensive to build for something that might only be used once a year, or less.

But Greenlee is researching

whether a shelter made from unreinforced concrete blocks can withstand tornado-force winds and be cost efficient. He said concrete alone is not used enough in structures like shelters.

"Let's push this material as far as we can and see what can come out of it and hopefully contribute something to research that potentially could be used in the future," Greenlee said.

In general, 3D-printed concrete has several advantages. It's increasingly being used in

construction for homes and businesses. There can be cost savings, with less waste and labor. And the concrete can be formed into many different shapes and sizes, unlike the square concrete block structures usually built.

That flexible shape is what gives Greenlee's blocks their strength. These blocks are shaped more like repeating coils, which Greenlee said looks like strips of solid material running the height of the shelter.

"That geometry helps

with deflecting impact debris," Greenlee said. "In the direction that the material is being laid, there's this interesting dynamic property that we'll be testing through Federal Emergency Management Agency's impact load testing for storm shelters."

Since he's currently in the research phase, Greenlee said he is still exploring whether the blocks will meet FEMA's standards for tornado shelters. And it remains to be seen if this method is more cost efficient, he said.

"We're excited about it, but we really need that physical hard data to start to

understand the real potential," Greenlee said.

However, some benefits are clear to Greenlee. The blocks can be manufactured off-site in a modular fashion. It's the same advantage manufactured housing has that makes it affordable.

Since the 3D-printed concrete structures can be made in a wide variety of shapes and sizes, they can also have several functions.

A storm shelter that doubles as a community or recreation center offers multiple benefits. These 3D-printed concrete blocks could build something that creates greater community bonds while also providing

protection.

"Start to look at shelters as pieces of infrastructure or architecture that can double as something else," Greenlee said. "The main kind of interest for us is a storm shelter that doesn't have to just exist as a bunker its whole life."

Greenlee hopes additional research and development could help reduce the stigma of manufactured construction.

"I would love for the manufactured housing just to be more understood as a great and deeply affordable housing stock that we have available in the U.S.," Greenlee said.

said.

"It will not be the last." The settlement ended a high-stakes, landmark case, filed in 2023, in which states said Meta purposely designed its social media platforms with addictive features, that Meta knew it was exposing children to serious mental harms, and that it intentionally misled the public about the safety of those platforms.

Meta has not admitted wrongdoing.

The federal trial began last week in Oakland, California, led by a bipartisan group of attorneys general from California, Colorado, Kentucky and New Jersey.

State officials are calling the settlement the biggest consumer protection win since the Big Tobacco settlements of the 1990s.

Kentucky Attorney General Russell Coleman, a Republican, said in a statement Wednesday that the lawsuit was "never just about the money."

"Kids deserve a childhood that isn't measured in likes and followers," he said. "The online protections delivered by this settlement will bring a generational change that will make social media platforms safer for Kentucky families."

In addition to the financial settlement, Meta agreed to make major changes to its Instagram and Facebook features for young users, including a daily time limit, automatic pauses, nighttime blocks that restrict access from midnight to 6 a.m., and

stronger safeguards against bullying and harmful content. Most of the updates must be in place for at least a decade.

Meta is trying to drag its competitors along with it. The company agreed to further restrict daily time limits for teens only if TikTok and YouTube agree to adopt comparable measures.

Under the settlement terms, Meta will pay out just 70 percent (about \$12.7 billion) to states unless TikTok and Alphabet-owned YouTube also agree to set one-hour daily time limits for young users, as well as night mode and age assurance measures.

Meta will pay the remaining 30 percent – \$5.3 billion – if the other two companies agree to the new measures and each agrees to pay states about \$5.3 billion.

C.J. Mahoney, chief legal officer at Meta, said in a statement that the changes needed to be made across the social media landscape to have an impact.

"Our new Time Limit commitments, Night Mode features and usage limits during school hours set the right path forward for our whole industry, but this framework will only work if all our peers join us," Mahoney said.

"Because teens move fluidly across dozens of apps, we need an industry-wide solution."

Settlement money will be paid out to the participating states and territories annually over a decade, based on their populations.

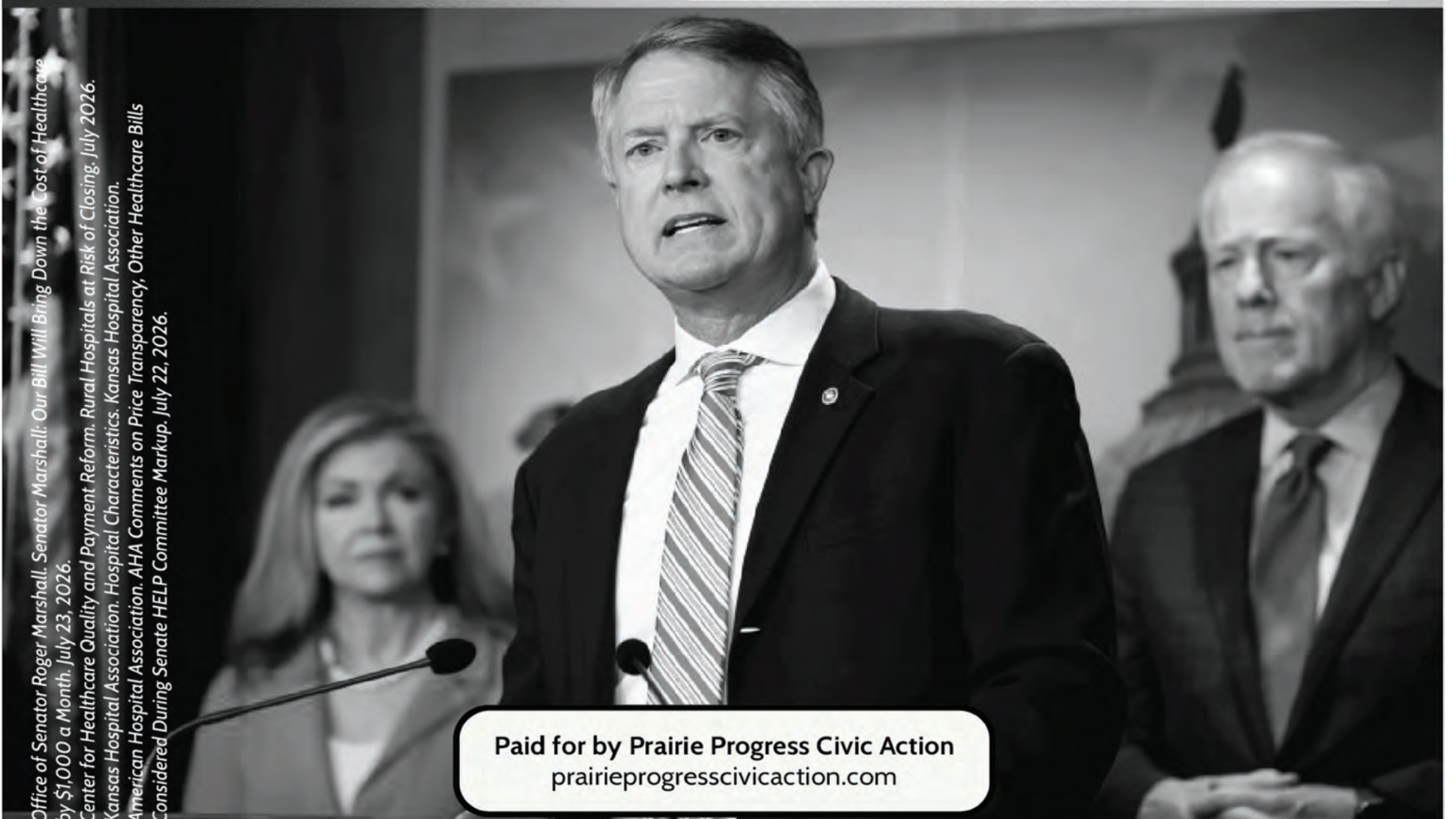
But for many Kansans, access to healthcare is already under threat.
